

Clinical Research Associate (CRA)

Medical studies for scientists and medical professionals as well as for members of the medical-technical occupations.

Before each drug is approved there is a long term of research, development and clinical trials. The clinical monitor (CRA/Clinical Research Associate) in this instance represents the connection between the pharmaceutical industry and the medical investigator and is the neutral part that ensures the validation of the trial as far as the abidance by the law. Major tasks of the CRAs are the guidance of the investigator, evaluation of research and trial data recorded by the investigator and safe-guarding of guidelines and laws to which all parties have to comply.

The CRA cooperates closely with the Clinical Data Manager, who is responsible for electronic collection, evaluation and encoding of the study data. Apart from special knowledge of medical applications and terminology as well as fundamental knowledge of pharmacology and toxicology, also fundamental knowledge of execution and evaluation of the different phases of clinical trials is essential to the CRA.

According to that knowledge of the legal basic conditions for approval of drugs is just as necessary as professional handling of data processing and the ability to communicate with different occupational groups of the medical-technical personnel. Organisational and logistic abilities are just as in demand as perfect English language skills.

To the seminar

The functions of the CRA (clinical monitor) are not fixed by an official job description and can be arranged differently according to the applied profession in question. You will be trained and taught by qualified scientists and personnel with professional background training in the nursing area of medical-technical occupations. The theoretical phase of the seminar qualifies the participants for the tasks of a CRA. In the following praxis-oriented phase of two month time there will be given the possibility of using practical contents learned and studied before in order to integrate your person into the desired profession.
